

Workshops

Storyhouse workshops are led by professional artists. Your students will learn, create and be inspired through practical sessions with a child-centered approach.

We offer a range of workshops all year round for schools, designed to support your curriculum through Creative Education.

Covid-19 Secure

All workshops are Covid-19 secure and can be delivered in your school or virtually. We can support you to reach those students who are working remotely, please contact us to discuss further. We will:

- Demonstrate excellent hygiene. Washing hands regularly and thoroughly.
- Minimise contact and maintain distancing throughout the activity for staff and students.
- Use face coverings where required.
- Maintain 'bubbles' and requirements as set out by the school.
- Reduce the number of groups taught and locations worked in, to reduce the number of contacts made.
- Use the NHS test and trace process and respond rapidly.
- Ensure good practice with remote and virtual working.
- Willing to work within your guidance and carry out regular testing.

Partner Schools

We have a successful model of working in creative partnerships with primary and secondary schools, Colleges and Universities. Working alongside teachers our Creative Learning Practitioners enhance the learning of children and young people as part of Storyhouse Schools' Residency.

Storyhouse Schools' Residency runs throughout the academic year. A Storyhouse Creative Practitioner spends one day per week in your school, leading arts-based curriculum workshops, designed by Storyhouse in partnership with you. Also includes access to our Digital Library of workshops!

We recruit schools onto our Schools' Residency during the Spring & Summer Term to start in the new academic year.

This arts-based curriculum-enrichment programme will be designed in collaboration with you, to meet your needs, differentiated for your students and your schools improvement plan. Students will gain confidence, self-expression and teamwork and teachers will be supported to elevate the value of performing arts in your school.

Cost: £6,150 (per academic year)
